Advice on images

Too many Drawing Inspiration Award applications are let down by poor photographs. It is important that the images accompanying your application are carefully edited to tell the story of your event and represent both activities and results. Approximately 20 images should be enough for this purpose. Here is a list of common mistakes; please avoid them:

1. Pictures only of the final work
2. Pictures only of people engaged in the activity
3. Too much repetition
4. The same image taken from multiple angles or at different zooms
5. Too few images
6. Focusing on something in your description that is not illustrated by an image
7. Unedited/uncropped images
8. Images which have not been rotated correctly
9. Photos of small children doing nothing!
